<input type="checkbox"/> Logistics		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Responsible for general support services, including, but not limited to, distribution of emergency supplies, stockpiled food provisions, transportation support, and the like
<input type="checkbox"/> Assurance (Observers)		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Determine compliance to emergency protocols and in documentation (photo, video, etc.) of events during emergency drills and actual emergencies
<input type="checkbox"/> Assurance (Inspectors)		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Conduct periodic safety and post-emergency assessments based on established standards
<input type="checkbox"/> Communications (Internal)	Employees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Identify and manage a viable communication network to relay advisories and instructions relating to emergencies, from preparation to post-emergency activities
<input type="checkbox"/> Communications (External)		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Manage all communication requirements for external entities, including but not limited to hospitals, government agencies, and the like - DOES NOT COVER communication to media and next-of-kin individuals
<input type="checkbox"/> Search and Recon		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Locate victims in the emergency-affected areas for communication to rescue teams - Identify alternative evacuation areas during actual emergencies in the performance of their reconnaissance function
<input type="checkbox"/> Technical Operations	Employees <i>(with relevant experience)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Provide technical support - This group consists of members requiring specialized training, both basic and advanced, such as fire-fighting, handling of hazardous materials (hazmat), hostage negotiations, and the like
<input type="checkbox"/> Recovery		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Provide post-emergency trauma management
<input type="checkbox"/> Medical		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Provide medical support - This group is open to all medical professionals, such as physicians, nurses, and the like, with relevant experience in emergency services.
