Crowd Control (Marshal)	<ul> <li>Maintain order and direct people to designated evacuation areas or other safe areas during emergency drills or actual emergencies.</li> <li>Determine if a complete evacuation has been achieved</li> </ul>	Yes	Yes
Logistics	- Responsible for general support services, including, but not limited to, distribution of emergency supplies, stockpiled food provisions, transportation support, and the like	Yes	Yes
Assurance (Observers)	- Determine compliance to emergency protocols and in documentation (photo, video, etc.) of events during emergency drills and actual emergencies	Yes	Yes
Assurance (Inspectors)	Conduct periodic safety and post-emergency assessments based on established standards	Yes	Yes
Communications (Internal)	Identify and manage a viable communication network to relay advisories and instructions relating to emergencies, from preparation to post-emergency activities		Yes
Communications (External)	<ul> <li>Manage all communication requirements for external entities, including but not limited to hospitals, government agencies, and the like</li> <li>DOES NOT COVER communication to media and next-of-kin individuals</li> </ul>		Yes
Search and Recon	<ul> <li>Locate victims in the emergency-affected areas for communication to rescue teams</li> <li>Identify alternative evacuation areas during actual emergencies in the performance of their reconnaissance function</li> </ul>		Yes
Technical Operations	<ul> <li>Provide technical support</li> <li>This group consists of members requiring specialized training, both basic and advanced, such as fire-fighting, handling of hazardous materials (hazmat), hostage negotiations, and the like</li> </ul>		Yes
Recovery	- Provide post-emergency trauma management		Yes
Medical	<ul> <li>Provide medical support</li> <li>This group is open to all medical professionals, such as physicians, nurses, and the like, with relevant experience in emergency services.</li> </ul>		Yes (with relevant experience)
